



# JOIN AUTISM-EUROPE'S WIN-WITH-U EVENT ON 24 MAY

## BUILDING AN INCLUSIVE SOCIETY FOR AUTISTIC PEOPLE

Autism-Europe (AE) is organising its WIN-WITH-U Erasmus+ project multiplier event on 24 May 2023. It will be part of a side-conference to the European Parliament for People with Disabilities (EPPD) event on 23 May in Brussels. AE's side-conference is hosted by Member of European Parliament (MEP) Chiara Maria Gemma (ECR, Italy) on 24 May 2023 from 14.00h to 18.00h in the European Parliament. Next to the results for the WIN-WITH-U project, other initiatives and projects to foster access to education and employment for autistic people will be presented. AE's WIN-WITH-U multiplier event will include special on-site participation from representatives of project coordinator LUISS Business School and project partner Specialisterne Denmark.

The side-conference's second panel starting around 15.40h Brussels time constitutes AE's multiplier event for the "Workplace Inclusion and employment opportunities for youth WITH autism" (WIN-WITH-U) project. The project coordinator from LUISS Business School will give an introduction to the project results focusing on the two learning paths and other tools to target autistic jobseekers and employers who want to improve their knowledge about autism. The panel comes with special participation of Carsten Lassen, CEO of WIN-WITH-U project partner Specialisterne Denmark deliberating on how to pave the way for inclusion at work. Autism-Europe's autistic board member Vincent Grimaldi de Puget, a managing director and clinical professor, will introduce this second panel and share insights into current research of examining unconscious biases facing autistic talents.

Autism-Europe's conference at the European Parliament in Brussels with simultaneous interpretation in English and Italian is titled "Building inclusive education and employment for autistic people". This EPPD side-conference is running under AE's current campaign "Building an inclusive society for autistic people".
